History of American-Style Windmills

In 1854, Daniel Halladay developed the American-type windmill. It was smaller, less expensive and could be shipped and built easily. Its sails were held into the wind by a weight, which would rise slowing to reduce the area of the sails when the wind was too fast. Traditional cloth covered sails were soon replaced with smaller wooden blades.



These new windmills were ideal for settlers on the plains. They could pump water from great depths at a steady rate. They could shift into the prevailing winds and functioned well in fast and slow winds. And to top it off, they required little maintenance compared to European windmills.

Self-governing water pump windmills soon became a staple on the plains.

Homesteaders, farmers, and ranchers were no longer dependent on natural water as they could drill wells and pump water. Windmills were often among a homesteader's most prized possessions. The water pumped by windmills was used to cook, bathe, drink, water crops and animals, wash clothes, and more. These mills were simple, well-constructed, and dependable.

Railroads were another important customer. Steam locomotives had to be watered at regular intervals. On the first transcontinental railroad, windmills were placed about every twenty miles to pump water for the trains.

Knowing windmills could be counted on for water helped speed up western migration. Ranchers could build up herds, farmers planted more, and railroads could pump water into tanks along their routes. The availability of water allowed the Great Plains to become the nation's breadbasket.

When we moved onto our Texas farm and into our new barndominium—horses below, home above—we quickly learned just how hot a vaulted ceiling could get. The floor sat at a comfortable 70 degrees, but up in the rafters, it was over 100.

Everyone said the same thing: You need ceiling fans. So I searched high and low for the right one—but nothing captured the rustic charm I wanted. One day, looking out across our pasture, I saw our old windmill spinning in the breeze, and it hit me: that was it.

After **lots of research and design**, I built my first Windmill Ceiling Fan—crafted from aluminum for strength and balance, but light enough to hang anywhere. It worked perfectly, and soon, word began to spread. From that single idea, **The Windmill Ceiling Fan & Lighting Co. was born.**

Best Fishing DAYS & TIMES

THE BEST TIMES TO FISH ARE WHEN THE FISH ARE NATURALLY MOST ACTIVE. The Sun, Moon, tides and weather all influence fish activity. For example, fish tend to feed more at sunrise and sunset, and also during a full Moon (when tides are higher than average). However, most of us go fishing simply when we can get the time off. But there are best times, according to fish lore.

- One hour before and one hour after high tides, and one hour before and one hour after low tides. The times of high tides for Boston are given on the Left Hand Calendar Pages; also see Tide Corrections. (Inland, the times for high tides correspond with the times when the Moon is due south. Low tides are halfway between high tides.)
- During the "morning rise" (after sunup for a spell) and the "evening rise" (just before the sundown and then the hour or so after).
- During the rise and set of the Moon.
- Just before the arrival of a storm, although the falling barometric pressure will eventually slow down their feeding. Angling can also be good when the pressure is either steady or on the rise 1 to 2 days after a storm. High pressure accompanying clear weather can bring on sluggishness and reduced activity.
- When there is a hatch of flies - caddis flies or mayflies, commonly.
- When the breeze is from a westerly quarter, rather than from the north or east.
- When the water is still or slightly rippled, rather than during a wind.

HOW TO ESTIMATE THE WEIGHT OF A FISH

- Measure the fish from the tip of its nose to the tip of its tail. Then measure its girth at the thickest portion of its midsection.
- The weight of a fat-bodied fish (bass, salmon) = (length X girth X girth)/800
- The weight of a slender fish (trout, northern pike) = (length X girth X girth)/900

RECIPE

Title: **TIM O'CONNELL'S HERB-CRUSTED PRIME RIB**

Cook Time: 15 MIN PER POUND

Serves: 1/2-3/4 LB PER ADULT

Ingredients

2 GARLIC CLOVES, SLIVERED (PRO TIP: INSERT GARLIC INTO SLITS IN THE ROAST THE NIGHT BEFORE COOKING FOR EXTRA FLAVOR.)

OLIVE OIL, FOR RUBBING

2 CUPS WATER (FOR THE ROASTING PAN)

MALDON OR PREFERRED SALT (ENOUGH FOR GENEROUS LAYER)

CRACKED BLACK PEPPER (HALF AS MUCH AS SALT)

HERB DE PROVENCE OR ITALIAN SEASONING

1/3 CONTAINER DRIED OREGANO

FRESH ROSEMARY SPRIGS (1/2 ON TOP, 1/2 IN THE PAN)

FRESH THYME SPRIGS (1/2 ON TOP, 1/2 IN THE PAN)

1 SHALLOT, FINELY CHOPPED (SOME ON TOP, SOME IN THE PAN)

WHEN SUPPER NEEDS A SHOW PONY, 3X BAREBACK WORLD CHAMP TIM O'CONNELL SADDLES UP A PRIME RIB THAT NEVER MISSES—SLOW, HERBY, AND WORTH THE VICTORY LAP.

Instructions

PREHEAT OVEN TO 275

PREPARE THE ROAST: RUB PRIME RIB WITH OLIVE OIL AND SEASON GENEROUSLY WITH SALT, PEPPER, HERBS, AND SPICES. INSERT GARLIC SLIVERS INTO THE SLITS IF PREPARED THE NIGHT BEFORE.

ARRANGE IN PAN: PLACE ROSEMARY, THYME, AND SHALLOTS BOTH ON THE ROAST AND IN THE ROASTING PAN. ADD 2 CUPS OF WATER TO THE BOTTOM OF THE PAN.

ROAST: COOK THE PRIME RIB FOR 15 MINUTES PER POUND, OR UNTIL THE INTERNAL TEMPERATURE REACHES 130°F FOR MEDIUM-RARE.

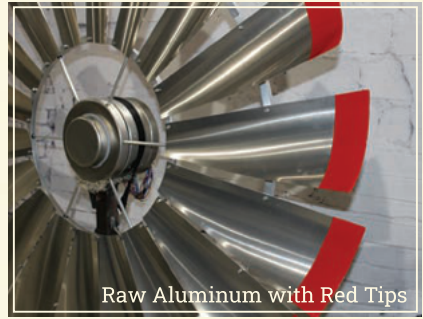
CRISP THE OUTSIDE: FOR A CRISPY EXTERIOR, INCREASE THE OVEN TO 450°F ON CONVECTION BAKE AND COOK FOR AN ADDITIONAL 15-20 MINUTES.

REST AND SERVE: REMOVE FROM THE OVEN, COVER WITH FOIL, AND LET REST FOR 1 HOUR BEFORE CARVING. SERVE WITH PAN JUICES FOR ADDED FLAVOR.

THE GENERAL WEATHER REPORT AND FORCAST

What's shaping the weather? Solar Cycle 25 is peaking, with its peak already exceeding that of Solar Cycle 24. Historically, solar cycles have been linked to temperature trends, on average, across Earth, but this relationship has become weaker in recent decades. The transition of La Niña from weak to neutral is another important factor. Oscillations are linked to ocean-atmosphere weather patterns recurring over long periods. We expect the warm phase of the Atlantic Multidecadal Oscillation and the cool phase of the Pacific Decadal Oscillation to continue. We're also monitoring the stratospheric winds near the equator, the Quasi-Biennial Oscillation. Some or all of these factors may cause the polar vortex to displace southward this winter, sending cold air from across Canada south into the United States.

WINTER: will be colder than normal from the Appalachians southward through the Southeast and Florida and westward across the Ohio Valley and near normal or milder elsewhere. Precipitation will be below normal for most areas, except for near-to above-normal amounts across Florida and from the southern High Plains through the Intermountain region and the eastern Desert Southwest. Snowfall will be above normal for much of the Carolinas and throughout the southern Appalachians, into the eastern Ohio Valley, and across the southern Rockies and eastern Desert Southwest. Snowfall will be near to below normal everywhere else.

SPRING: temps will be warmer than normal for most places, but near normal or cooler across parts of the eastern Upper Midwest and from the northern Rockies through much of the northern Pacific Northwest. Rainfall will be above normal from the southern Appalachians through the eastern Ohio Valley, from the western Lower Lakes through much of the Upper Midwest, the Tennessee Valley through the southern Plains and New Mexico, northward along the front range of the Rockies into the northern Intermountain region, and across northern Alaska and central and western Hawaii.

SUMMER: will be hotter than normal, except for near-to below-normal temps across the northern Appalachians, from the Heartland through the Upper Midwest, from the northern Rockies to the Washington and northern Oregon

coasts, and throughout Alaska. Rainfall will be above normal across the northern Northeast and the Lower Lakes through the Heartland, from the South Carolina coast through the Gulf Coastal Plain into Texas and Oklahoma, across the lower Rockies through the Great Basin, over western Washington and northwest Oregon, and across Alaska and central and western Hawaii; it will be near to below normal elsewhere.

Watch for a **TROPICAL DEPRESSION** in Florida in early November and in the northern Appalachians in late June. The best chances for **TROPICAL STORM** will be in Texas in late May, the Deep South in early June, Florida through the Atlantic Corridor in late June, the Atlantic Corridor in mid-August, across the Deep South and Texas in late August, and Hawaii in mid-September. Watch for a **HURRICANE** across Florida and the Southeast in mid-August.

Autumn: will be cooler than normal, except for near normal or warmer temps from the Deep South through most of Texas and the Heartland, from the High Plains through the central Rockies and the Desert Southwest, and across southern Alaska. Rainfall will be above normal in the Northeast, across southern Florida, from Oklahoma into Texas, from the central and northern Rockies through much of the West Coast, and across Hawaii. It will be near to below normal everywhere else.
